



Sweet Acacia

Acacia farnesiana



Heavily cultivated in Europe for its flowers as a perfume ingredient, this plant has small yellow-orange, ball-like flowers. Its limbs and trunk have spines so care should be taken when handling/planting. Plants are capable of producing suckers that can form thickets. This plant has a high calcium tolerance. A member of the mimosa family, this tree will produce bean-shaped pods.

- Grows 15-20 feet
- Found sandy to clay soils
