



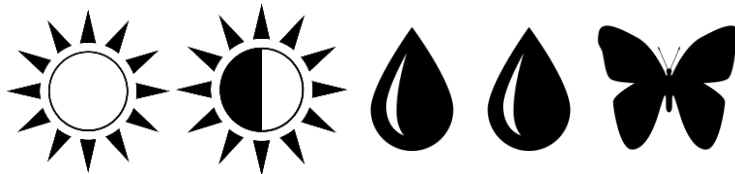
# Yellow Colic-Root

*Aletris lutea*



This plant is in the lily family and also known as “unicorn root” or “stargrass” because of its ring of basal leaves. While not very wide, this plant’s flower spike can get up to 4 feet high while the plant itself stays tucked close to the ground. Because of this growth, this plant prefers open, moist habitat with no plants to shade it out. It tends to die back after setting seed in the summer.

- Perennial
- Found in open, moist savannahs and flatwoods
- basal rosette
