



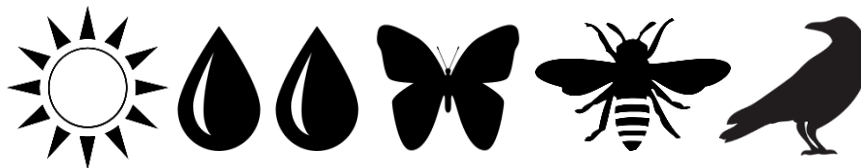
Sea Oxeeye Daisy

Borrichia frutescens



This cheerful plant has fuzzy, fleshy leaves that are gray-green in color. This species is unique because it is salt-tolerant, and for this reason can often be found along beach dunes. Creeping rhizomes spread the plant. Flowers are bright yellow, appearing in late summer. Birds may feed on the seeds.

- Grows 3 feet
- Found in marshes, tidal flats
