Dichromena colorata



This species is a great pond edge or ditch plant! The white “flowers” are actually modified leaves surrounding the real flowers, and appear for most of the year! A good groundcover, this plant can be used for savannahs or water gardens. Plants can take acidic to mildly alkaline soil conditions.

- Perennial
- Grows 2 feet
- Found along ponds, wet prairies, marshes
