



Elephant's Foot

Elephantopus tomentosus



This plant has large, hairy, low-lying leaves that lay on the ground. Stems have few or no leaves, and can branch into multiple flower stalks. As a member of the daisy family, “flowers” are actually made up of many small, true flowers.

- Perennial
- Grows 2 feet
- Found in old fields, meadows, forest edges
