



Silver plume grass

Erianthus alopecuroides



This tall bunch grass produces silvery plumes held up to 10 ft high. Seeds provide food to birds and animals. Great plant for the back of a garden. Best grown in average, somewhat dry, well-drained soils in full sun. Cut foliage to the ground in late winter before new shoots appear. Best of all, it's highly deer resistant!

Perennial - Grows 3 - 10 feet - Found in sandy soils, woodlands and forest edges
