



Slender Goldentop

Euthamia caroliniana



This plant is not a true goldenrod. Leaves are slender and grass-like with resinous dots. This plant is advantageous because it's one of the last to bloom, often into December. Well placed clusters of plants can create a dazzling display of yellow for the fall. Plants spread through rhizomes.

- Perennial
- Grows 3 feet
- Found on wetland edges & dune swales
