Flowers are a semi-showy green that attract native bees. An abundant supply of purple to dark blue fruits form after pollinating and these provide food to birds. A large shrub, this plant can tolerate a wide range of soil conditions. This plant is considered rare.

- Perennial
- Grows 10-15 feet
- Found in hammocks, thickets, scrub, middens
